

Stage 3, Page 5, Route B - -ct, -ft and -pt

The consonants ct, ft and pt can come after a vowel in words.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it**
e.g. 'fact, f ... a ... c ... t'



For each line, trace over the first two words and then write two of your own.

A **fact** is something that is true.

Lisa **left** her book at school.

Swift is another word for quick.
