

Stage 4, Page 5, Route A/B - (or) as 'oor' and 'oar'

When the sound (or) comes at the end of words it is normally spelt 'ore'. The words floor, door and poor are naughty red words that belong to Bart because they end in the sound (or), but this sound is spelt with 'oor' and not 'ore'.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it** e.g. 'floor, f ... l ... o ... o ... r'



For each line, trace over the first two words and then write two of your own.

The words oar, roar, soar and board are naughty red words that belong to Bart because they are some of the few words that use the letters 'oar' for the sound (or).

soar soar



A **board** is a flat bit of wood.
