

Stage 4, Page 6, Route A/B - (or) as 'our'

The sound (or) is normally spelt 'or' when it comes within a word.
When the sound (or) comes at the end of words it is normally spelt 'ore'.

The words four, fourth, tour, pour, court and mourn are naughty red words that belong to Bart because they are some of the few words that use the letters 'our' for the sound (or).

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it**
e.g. 'four, f ... o ... u ... r'
