

Stage 5, Page 5, Route A/B - (or) as 'au' in the middle of words

In quite a few words the sound (or) is made by the letters 'au' like those below.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it**
e.g. 'haunt, h ... a ... u ... n ... t'
