The letters oo together can make two different sounds. One of these sounds is the sound that the letters oo make in the words below.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it** e.g. 'good, g ... o ... o ... d'



For each line, trace over the first two words and then write two of your own.

The words blood and flood are naughty red words that belong to Bart because the letters oo make the short (u) sound, like in mud.



A river can **flood** if there is a lot of rain.

flood flood



Your heart pumps **blood**.

blood blood
