

Stage 7, Page 6, Route A/B - (ooz)

Not very many words end in the sound (ooz). Because there are so few of these words and there are a few ways of spelling this sound they are all naughty words.

Remember: Say the word aloud, then say each letter aloud **as you write it** e.g. 'juice, j ... u ... i ... c ... e'
